Members of the public, Planning and Zoning Commission and city employees may participate in the meeting virtually, as long as a quorum of the Planning and Zoning Commission and the presiding officer are physically present at the Municipal Building, in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

## 3. ANNOUNCEMENTS / PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION COMMENTS

Pursuant to Texas Government Code Sec. 551.0415, a member of the governing body may make an announcement about items of community interest during a meeting of the governing body without given notice of the subject of the announcement. Items of Community Interests include: (1) expressions of thanks, congratulations, or condolence; (2) information regarding holiday schedule; (3) an honorary or salutary recognition of public official, public employee, or other citizen, except that a discussion regarding a change in the status of a person's public office or public employment is not an honorary or salutary recognition of the subdivision; (4) a reminder regarding social, ceremonial, or community event organized or sponsored by an entity other than the governing body that was attended or is scheduled to be attended by a member of the governing body or an official or employee of the political subdivision; and (5) announcements involving imminent threat to the public health and safety of people in the political subdivision that has arisen after the posting of the agenda.

#### 4. PUBLIC COMMENT

In accordance with the Texas Attorney General's Opinion, any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the Planning and Zoning Commission. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, or comment will be made by the Planning and Zoning Commission. Public comments related to agenda items will be heard at the time the item is called.

Public comment will be allowed in person or remotely via telephone. Speakers may only register to speak on an item once, either in-person or remotely, and will be allowed up to three minutes to provide their comments. Registration no later than noon the day before the meeting is required for remote participation by telephone.
